We have the pleasure of inviting you to participate in the Workshop 2008 of ICOFOF LAM, the Regional Sub-committee of ICOFOF for Latin America and the Caribbean, to be realized from March 5 to 7, in the city of Rio de Janeiro, Brazil.

ICOFOF LAM has been specially invited by the Federal University of the State of Rio de Janeiro – UNIRIO and by the Museum of Astronomy and Related Sciences – MAST, to realize this workshop. The theme for discussion will be ***Museology as a Disciplinary Field***, and the intention is to start the process of analysis of the theoretical production of ICOFOF LAM (1992/2006), emphasizing its contribution to the development of the field of Museology.

According to its traditional methodology of work, the Regional Subcommittee will offer two keynote speeches by two renowned specialists, Profs. Drs. Nélide González de Gómez and Lena Vania Ribeiro Pinheiro, as well as the traditional discussion groups, where participants will be able to analyze and debate the contents of some of the main documents produced by ICOFOF LAM in its fifteen years of consecutive work. The main points discussed will be reflected in a final document.

We add to the present a preliminary program of activities, the theme and subthemes and the norms for the production of papers, as well as a pre-inscription form.

#### **Methodology**

Analysis of the theoretical production of ICOFOM LAM (1992/2006) and of its contribution to Museology as a disciplinary field.

### **NORMS FOR THE PRESENTATION OF DOCUMENTS**

The workshop will use the methodology developed for ICOFOM, including:

1. Production of theoretical papers on the theme to be discussed – by members of ICOFOM LAM and invited specialists – in Spanish and Portuguese (we will accept documents in English, by English speaking specialists);
2. Facilitating, through digital media, the contents of the final documents of the annual meetings of ICOFOM LAM (1992/2006), in Spanish and Portuguese;
3. constitution of working groups to analyze and discuss such documents;
4. producing a synthesis of the main points discussed, as base for a final document, to be distributed among the members of ICOFOM LAM and through the internet.

Written contributions will be accepted until February 22, ultimate deadline. Archives must be sent simultaneously to Lic. 1. Texts in format WinWord (.doc, .rtf) in Portuguese and/or Spanish
2. Pages in format A4 – margins – sup. 2.5, inf. 2.5, left and right 3.0
3. Heading: aligned to the left – title in bold, font Arial size 14; below, name, country and institution of the author, in Arial size 14, italic
4. Maximum of eight (08) pages of text, with one page of bibliography. Font Arial size 11, single space, citations and references numbered, as footnotes.
5. *Abstract* with around 20 lines, in Portuguese and/or Spanish, and in English.
